Professional Year (24 graduate credits)

The professional year requires a conferred BS degree; minimum 2.5 GPA in major; minimum 2.8 GPA in education courses; and a minimum cumulative (including transfer work) 2.75 GPA. To complete the master's degree, students must complete the professional year (24 credits) and an additional 12 credits of electives; consult with faculty advisor for graduate electives. Graduate electives may be completed before or after the professional year.
