Honors Program

Admission Requirements:

- Admitted to one of the college's undergraduate majors.
- Attainment of a minimum cumulative 3.5 GPA (based on the completion of at least 15 semester credit hours).
- Submission of a CEHHS Honors Program application to the CEHHS Office of Advising and Student Services, Bailey Education Complex 332.
- Individual meeting or communication with departmental coordinator.

Program Requirements:

- Two lower-division 3 credit hour honors courses. It is also possible to satisfy this requirement through lower-division honors coursework in the major and/or through Honors-by-Contract
- One 3 credit hour course with a service learning component as approved by the department. *May also be met through Honors-by-Contract* in which a service project is added to a course.*
- One upper-division 3 credit hour honors course in the student's academic major (e.g., A USP 493, CFS 497, KNS 497, NUTR 493, HRT 494, RCS 493, RSM 493, TPTE 493) through which the student will develop and present a capstone project at the university's annual Exhibition of Undergraduate Research and Creative Achievement or at an approved similar professional venue. This requirement may be met through Honors-by-Contract*.

**Honors-by-Contract requires completion of a written contract (available in the CEHHS Office of Advising & Student Services, BEC 332) delineating additional effort and is submitted to the College's honors coordinator by the third week of the semester.*

Program Completion:

Students who successfully complete the program requirements and maintain a minimum cumulative 3.5 GPA will be recognized during commencement (May graduates only) and have their participation in the CEHHS Honors Program so noted on their official transcript.
