## Additional Licensure Requirements

In addition to completing all undergraduate degree requirements, students must complete a professional year-long (fall and spring) internship at the graduate level. The professional year requires a conferred degree; minimum 2.5 GPA in the major; minimum 2.8 GPA in education courses; and a minimum cumulative 2.75 GPA. To earn a master's degree in CFS, students must complete the professional year (24 credits) and an additional 12 credits of electives; consult with faculty advisor to select graduate electives. Graduate electives may be completed before or after the professional year.
