Students must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 while in the program. Students must earn a grade of C or better in all Teacher Education courses. Students with less than a 2.75 GPA for two consecutive semesters will be dropped from the program. Students who fail to meet the standards for professional conduct during the course of their fieldwork will not be retained in the major.

**Major Sequencing:**

Students must be admitted to the Teacher Education Program prior to Term 3 due to course sequencing. The majority of coursework is restricted.
